

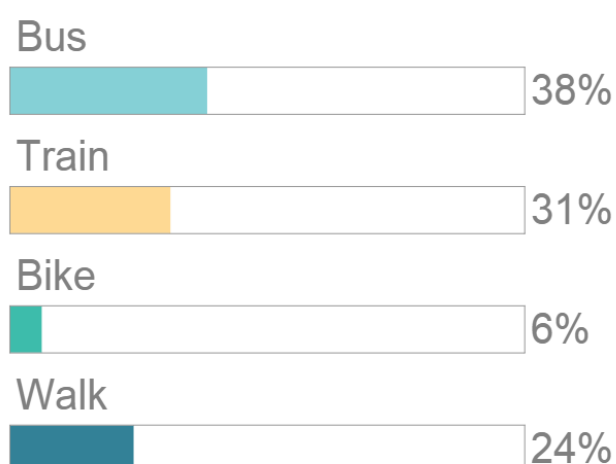

The top three things that young people enjoy about living in London were:

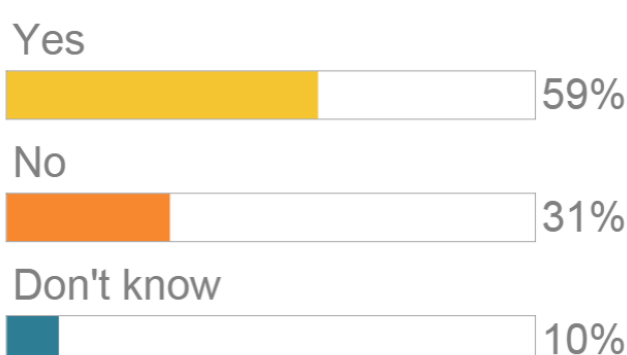
- Transport

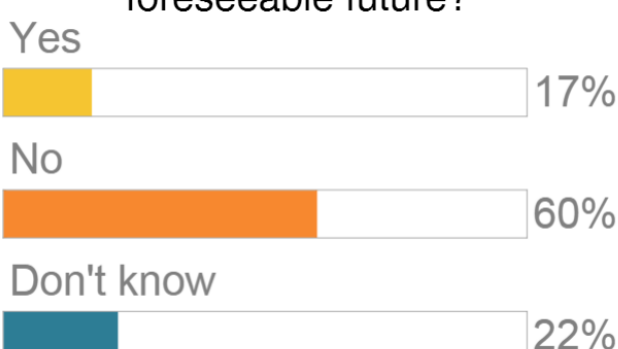
Do you want to live in London in the future?



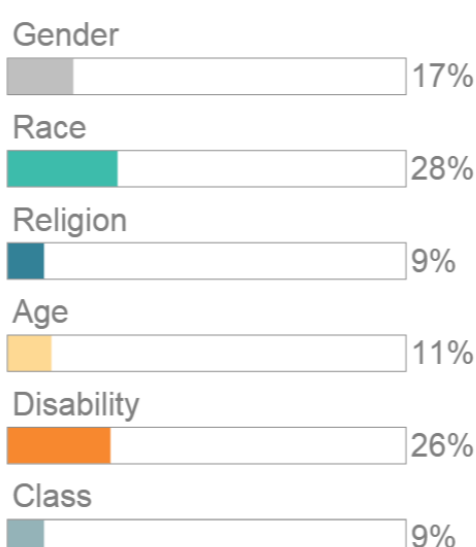
"I love London's diverse cultures, entertainment, facilities"

Have you ever faced discrimination? If so, in what form?



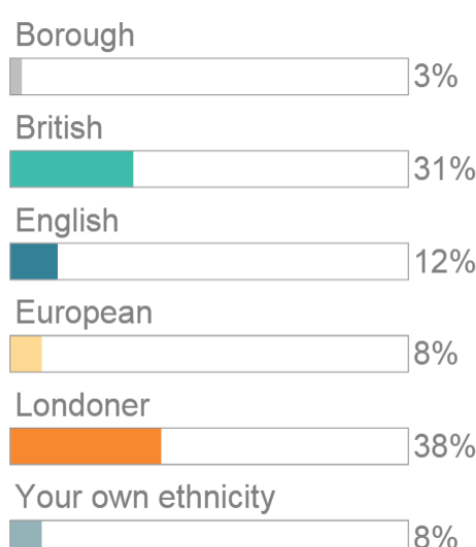

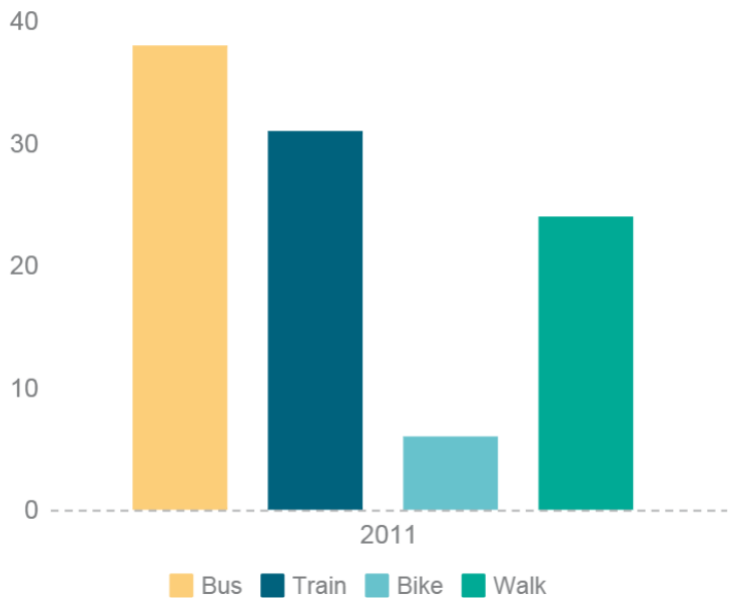

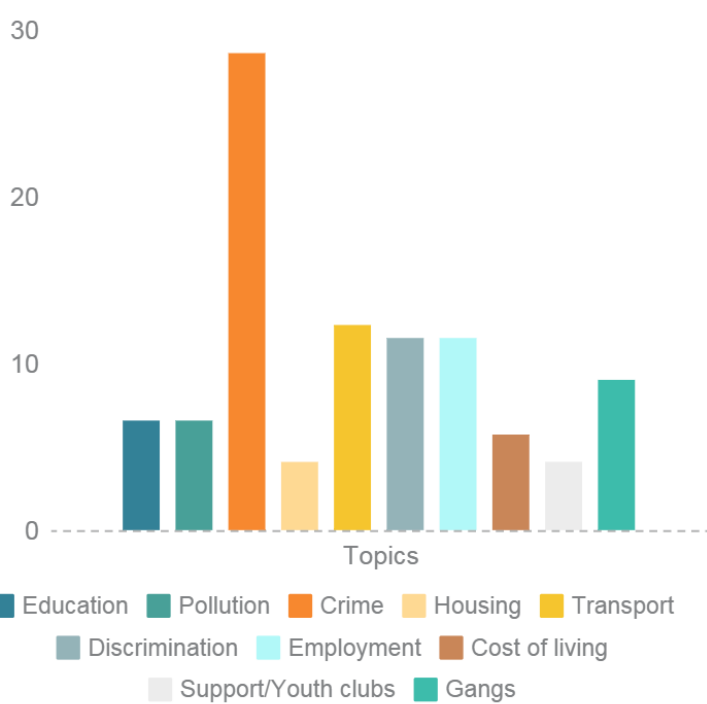
"Youth clubs are closed and not funded. Young people are bored and angry"
