The types of skills that Partnership for Young London can support you to develop include:

- **Events management** – including: event development, planning, publicity, communications, supporting delegates, and evaluation
- **Communications** – including:
 - The weekly and monthly update, sourcing and compiling research, opportunities for practitioners and young people, funding, policy news and European opportunities
 - Word Press – Updating the website with blogs, events, creating and editing content
 - Twitter and LinkedIn – sourcing materials to be communicated out via Twitter and LinkedIn
- **Policy and Information** – gaining knowledge about key policy developments that impact on young people, understanding how to source and gather information and increased awareness of key sites for useful information
- **Research Skills** – developing research skills on key projects, supporting the development of research reports and best practice briefings
- **Customer focus** – engaging with a range of organisations who work across London, dealing with enquiries, supporting people attending events and ensuring that all new contacts are included in future communications
