## EMPOWERING VOICES, INSPIRING CHANGE EVENT

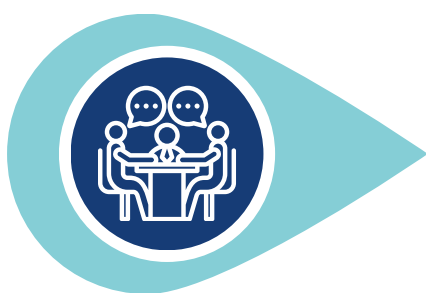
Syeda was a part of PYL's Youth Advisory Board that collaborated with other youth organisations to host a youth-led event all about empowering London's youth. Skills she developed included:
